Synopsis: On January 7, 2011, it was reported to the Division that Greyhound "BOC'S MAISIE MAE" ran in the seventh (7 th) race on January 3, 2011 at 1:55 PM finishing in seventh (7 th) place without incident. "BOC'S MAISIE MAE" was cooled down, seemed normal and then was placed in the greyhound hauler truck to return to the kennel. The assistant trainer heard a whining noise coming from the greyhound at 2:00 pm. When checked, she appeared to be in a seizure of some type. Dr. Bruce Olson, DVM, was called but found the greyhound had expired. Dr. Olson's report indicated the death was post-race and of unknown cause, possible aneurism or internal hemorrhage. "BOC'S MAISIE MAE" raced for the Stapleton Kennel LLC!, under the supervision of Trainer of Record, Alric A. WILLIAMS. The greyhound was placed in locked freezer for transport to University of Florida Small and Large Animal Hospital Pathology Department for necropsy. Exhibit # 1&2

CONTINUATION

On January 10, 2011: I transported this greyhound to the University of Florida Small and Large Animal Hospital Pathology Department for necropsy.

On January 16, 2011: I received a Preliminary Necropsy Report.

Gross Diagnoses:

- 1. Pulmonary edema, acute, diffuse, mild.
- 2. Tick infestation mild

Comment: No gross lesions were detected to explain the death of this dog. The pulmonary edema was mild and was likely a terminal event. Histopathology is pending. The final report requires four to six weeks for completion. Exhibit # 3

February 24, 2011: I received the University of Florida Veterinary Medical Center Pathology Department Necropsy Report. The final diagnosis is acute pulmonary edema (diffuse and mild) and acute myocardial degeneration (multifocal and mild). Because of the autolysis or freezing of the tissue, there is no clear cause of death. There was no physical trauma documented or identified. Exhibit # 4

There is no evidence to support physical abuse of the animal prior to the race. The exact cause cannot be determined. There are no identified violations of Florida State Statutes or PMW Rules by any participants in this incident.



CLINICAL SUMMARY AS WRITTEN BY SUBMITTING CLINICIAN: On 1/3/2011 at 1:55pm Greyhound raced finishing 7th place in the race. She was cooled down after race and placed in truck for transport to compound around .5miles away. Trainers heard noise and greyhound appeared to be having a seizure. Dr. Olson was called to scene and greyhound had expired. See attached Dr's. notes and notice of violation for more details. You may dispose of greyhound. Please take any relevant photographs. DATE OF DEATH: 1/3/2011; TIME: 2:00PM; ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS AFTER DEATH: After race just placed in truck; MANNER OF DEATH: Spontaneous.

CLINICAL DIAGNOSIS:

GROSS NECROPSY FINDINGS:

GENERAL EXAMINATION: The body is that of a 27.7kg, intact female, Greyhound in good physical and poor postmortem condition. The right ear has a tattoo 68D. The left ear has a tattoo 4736. There is a yellow ink "C" on the left ventral neck that measures 1.2x0.6cm. There is generalized red to purple discoloration of the skin, gums, and sclera. All organs not described are within normal limits. There are multiple areas of alopecia scattered over the body. There is an area on the right ventral neck (2.2x2.9cm), right cranial medial tibia (proximal 0.6mm diameter, middle 0.7mm diameter, distal 0.3x3.4cm), right medial distal tibia (1.6x0.3-1.3cm and 0.3cm diameter), right medial proximal tibia (1.4x0.5cm), left lateral distal tibia (1.3x0.5cm), right medial carpus (2.6x0.3cm), and right dorsal carpus (0.3cm diameter). There is a small amount of crusting on the ventral tail, in the area that contacts the vulva when the tail is tucked.

INTEGUMENT/SUBCUTIS: There is a 1 mm tick on the left lateral thigh. Another tick was found not attached to the body.

ABDOMINAL CAVITY: There is diffuse dark red discoloration to the abdominal viscera. THORACIC CAVITY: There is diffuse dark red discoloration to the thoracic contents.

UPPER RESPIRATORY TRACT: There is a small amount of tan foam located at the tracheal bifurcation and extending into the right and left mainstem bronchi.

RETENTION OF TISSUES: Routine. Samples of urine, aqueous and vitreous humor, fat, brain, liver, and kidney were frozen at -80°C.

COMMENT: There was severe autolysis of all the tissues. Autolysis can severely impair the identification and interpretation of subtle pathologic lesions. The myocardial degeneration was multifocal and mild. It could have contributed to death or have resulted secondary to the events that lead to the death of this animal. Possible causes include nutritional, toxic and other system disease (e.g., neural). Areas of myocardial damage can be arrhythmogenic and leave no other gross or microscopic lesions. The pulmonary edema was mild and likely a terminal event. The tick infestation was mild and considered incidental.
