Re: Kennel Inspections

Kennel inspections were performed today. I was accompanied by Mr. Jerry Bradford.

Greyhounds currently housed in the racing kennels:

The following were found:

Phat Kat Kennel:

1. A 20 ml syringe to which a needle could be attached was confiscated.
2. The kitchen area is generally dirty and the trainer was asked to clean the area.
3. Multiple dogs had flea dirt and live fleas. Because there has been a persistent flea infestation in this kennel the trainer was asked to clean and treat the cage room for fleas. He has done this in the past with the assistance of the maintenance department.
4. The kennel had a strong odor. The turnout pens held much standing water, this could be the source of the odor. Tilling, liming, and trenching the pens may aid correcting this problem. The assistance of the maintenance department may be needed as well.

Fine Line Racing:

The following injectable medications were found.

1. Pill bottle containing liquid medication, Label reads: Testosterone Cypionate 200mg/ml inject as directed. Evidence tag: A15198
2. 100 ml bottle Tylan 50 mg/ml Injectable. Evidence tag: A15199
3. 100 ml bottle Dexamethasone 2 mg/ml for injection. Evidence tag: A15200
4. 20ml bottle Batril 2.27% for injection
5. 3 ml syringes with 22 ga 3/4:" needles attached.
