ByANose Kennel:

Double G Kennel:

Greyhounds: 65 Crates: 72

Needs crates fixed. The trainer has not turned in a work order.

Fine Line Racing:

Greyhounds: 70 CrThe tTrainer has not turned in a work order.

Greyland Kennel:

Greyhounds: 72 Crates: 72

Needs sand in the turnout pens.

Jade Feise Kennel:

Greyhounds: Crates: 72

The kennel could not be inspected at this time

Phat Kat Kennel:

Greyhounds: 65 Crates: 72

A syringe to which a needle could be attached was found and confiscated. It was replaced with a proper syringe for giving oral medications.

Peter Lomax Kennel:
