GREY2K USA Worldwide's Database of State Disciplinary Records contains information from official State Racing Commission records. These records were obtained by GREY2K USA Worldwide through public information requests and are offered for informational purposes only.

The following states are represented in the database: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Iowa, Kansas, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Oregon, Texas, West Virginia, and Wisconsin. All of the rulings currently in GREY2K USA's possession have been included in the database.

The violation categories are as follows: **Abuse, Conduct, Death, Drugs, Injury, License, Miscellaneous, Neglect, Racing Rules, Vaccinations, and Weight/Weigh-Ins.** The violation type classifications are our own and do not reflect categorizations from source records. For example, where a greyhound tested positive for a prohibited substance, the category we used is that of "drugs." However, the category of "conduct" is used for a human that tested positive for drugs (or engaged in other negative behaviors). Additionally, the distinction between violations categorized as "abuse" vs. "neglect" reflects a case-by-case assessment made by GREY2K USA Worldwide staff.

### *Search Tips:*

- Use full word(s), not abbreviations or initials, when conducting a search. For example, type out "Tucson Greyhound Park," not "TGP."
- In order to get the best results, leave the Search Criteria as -ALL-. This will enable you to search all the columns of the database simultaneously.
- The "Name" column represents the respondent listed in the disciplinary records. Therefore this can be an individual, a corporation, the name of a greyhound track, or the name of a particular greyhound.
