**TEXT**

On June 12, 2016, in the 9<sup>th</sup> race of the Twilight performance, a positive sample (#69639) was taken on greyhound BORDER CAMPAIGN for the Ryan Farms Kennel trained by Tracy McMillin. At the time of the positive sample, Tracy McMillin was the trainer of the Ryan Farms Kennel. BORDER CAMPAIGN was a 3<sup>rd</sup> place finisher in a 9 dog race. The sample taken was found to contain Benzoylecgonine, a Class 1 drug. It is a DEA Schedule II narcotic substance.

On July 20, 2016, the Board of Judges asked Mr. McMillin directly if he used the drug Cocaine in the last 90 days. Mr. McMillin stated he has not used Cocaine. The Board of Judges then requested Mr. McMillin to submit to a drug screen, in which he agreed to. This is in accordance with ARC rule 3103. Mr. McMillin approved a hair sample to be taken. A hair sample was taken on July 21, 2016. Results were received on August 3, 2016 that Mr. McMillin had tested negative for Cocaine.

Due to the fact that 2 kennel helpers for Ryan Farms tested positive for cocaine and ARC rule #1333 stating "Trainers shall be responsible for and be the absolute insurer of the condition of an entry they enter regardless of the acts of third parties", the Board of Judges hereby fines trainer Tracy Mcmillin the maximum amount of \$1000.00 for the infraction and places BORDER CAMPAIGN to last and a re-distribution of purses.

You have 3 days in which to appeal this decision in writing to the office of the Commission. Appeals to the Commission shall be signed by the person making it and must set forth his/her reasons for believing he/she is entitled to a hearing.
